As a contingent paramedic student of Three Rivers College you are required to take the TEAS exam for placement into the paramedic program and score 50% or higher. You must register (if you have not done so) online at trcc.edu. Look under the ACADEMICS tab for Testing Center, click on Testing Center and scroll down to Allied Health Programs – ATI TEAS.

The ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS) is a computer-based exam that is required for admission into the Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT), Practical Nurse (PN), and Paramedic programs. This is a computer based diagnostic instrument that assists health occupations education programs evaluate academic aptitude, learning styles, and test taking skills of new applicants to their programs. The ATI TEAS is a four-part assessment with subtests in reading (28%), mathematics (20%), science (32%), and English and language usage (20%). Official score reports are available immediately after the test administration. The total testing time is four hours. Testing fee is \$75, which includes the Three Rivers proctoring fee. - You can only attend the test day/time for which you are registered. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the testing time. Please note that should you arrive late, and testing has begun, you will not be allowed to test.
- At the time of arrival, you will be given login information. Please bring a photo ID (you will not be allowed to test without a photo ID). No cell phones, pencils, calculators, or reference materials are allowed. All material needed will be supplied by Testing Services. Exam is approximately 4 hours.
- **To qualify as a viable paramedic applicant, the minimum overall score must be at 50% or above.**
- **If testing prior to the application deadlines, please submit test score with application.**
- **Applications MUST be submitted on or before the deadline date with test score or indicate the date you will be taking the exam.**
