In order to provide a healthy and safe work and learning environment, Three Rivers College fully complies with the current state, local and federal laws governing the health and safety of its students and employees. Therefore, the possession of firearms and weapons is prohibited on all college premises and from college activities. This policy does not apply to duly authorized law enforcement officials or to weapons legally possessed and concealed within the confines of a motor vehicle.

Missouri prohibits the carrying of a firearm, whether loaded or unloaded, or any other weapon readily capable of lethal use into any school, onto any school bus, or onto the premises of any function or activity sponsored or sanctioned by school officials or the board.

In Missouri, a concealed carry endorsement does not permit the holder to carry a concealed firearm into any school or college facility without the consent of a school official or the board. Possession of a firearm in a vehicle on the premises of any school facility is allowed as long as the firearm is not removed from the vehicle or brandished while the vehicle is on the premises (RSMo 571).
