To Prospective Students

Congratulations on choosing an exciting, fast-paced profession with substantial earning potential! In this packet you will find all the information you need to apply to the Three Rivers College Line Technician Program.

This program requires students to be in good physical health without mobility issues. Students in this program must possess coordination, dexterity, strength, and stamina. Students will also be required to be able to participate in the following physical activities:

- Climbing
- Balancing
- Stooping
- Kneeling
- Crouching
- Reaching
- Standing
- Walking
- Pushing
- Pulling
- Lifting 75 pounds to waist level
- Grasping

As a line technician, you should not have a fear of heights since the job will require you to work many feet off the ground as one of your job duties.

Admission Criteria

To become an eligible applicant, individuals must:

- Have completed an application to Three Rivers College.
- Be 18 years of age before start of Fall classes.
- Have completed an intake form for the TRC Line Technician Program.
- Have a valid driver's license.
- Place into College Writing and Mathematical Reasoning and Modeling on the ACT or ACCUPLACER placement tests (ACT scores are valid for 5 years).
- Subject to a confidential medical history, physical examination, two negative preadmission drug screens (one in the Fall and one in the Spring), and a clear criminal background check after acceptance to the program.

The intake form must be fully completed and received in the office no later than May 1st. The intake process consists of the following components and criteria:

1. Application Form to Three Rivers College

Students can either apply online at trcc.edu/admissions/application.php,

or fill out a paper application at any of the Three Rivers College locations. Please complete the application as instructed. The following are required as part of the admission process:

a. High School Transcript - A copy of an official transcript from the high school from which you graduated is required. This may be obtained by requesting that your school send the transcript to TRC at the address listed below. The transcript must have the school seal and/or signature of a school official. It cannot be hand carried by you to our office.

OR

High School Equivalency Credential – An official copy of the GED/HiSET scores and certificate must be sent directly to Three Rivers at the address listed below.

b. College Transcript - If you have college credit from an institution other than Three Rivers College, please contact your school and request that an official transcript be sent to Three Rivers College. The transcript must have the school seal and/or signature of a school official. You do not need to submit any Three Rivers College transcripts.

The admission process will consist of*:

- Review of intake form and transcripts
- Review of placement scores
- Pre-admission interview

*Due to the nature of the program, seats are limited. All applicants may not be admitted to the program. A scoring rubric will be used to determine the highest qualified applicants.
