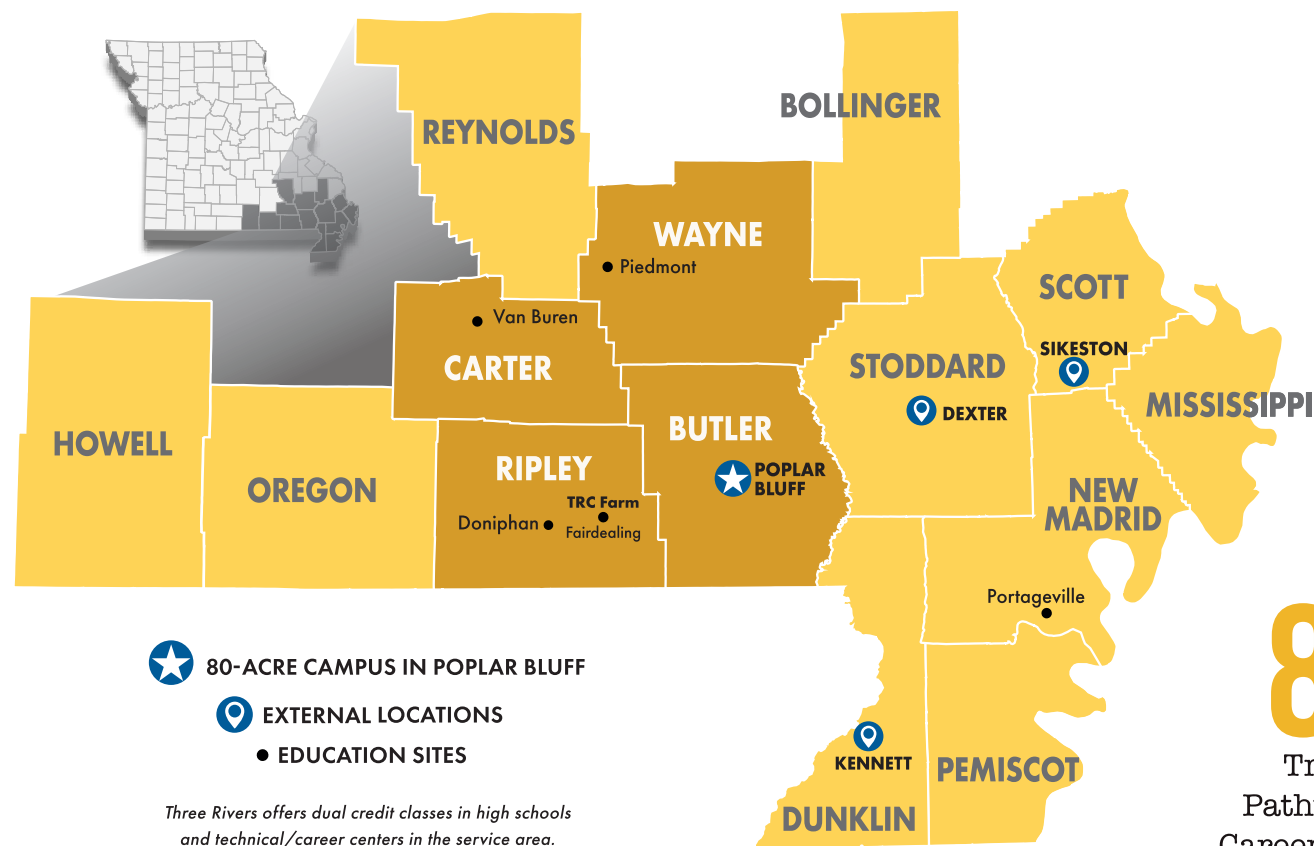

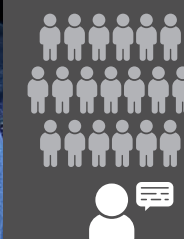

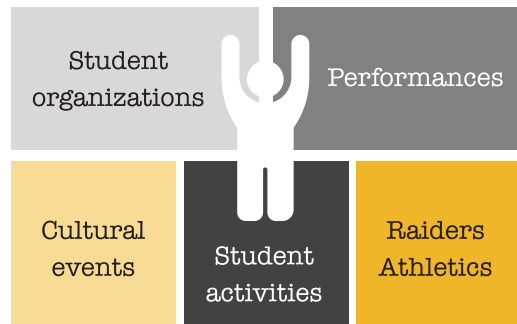
We offer fully online degrees and classes for those who need the convenience of online learning, while still getting one-on-one support from instructors, advisors, tutors, financial aid, and other staff.

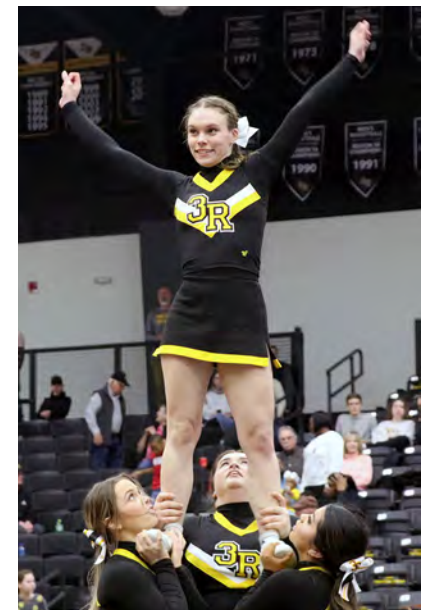

HOW OUR TIERED TUITION WORKS

Most classes are covered under base tuition. However, classes for certain programs such as nursing, welding, construction, and others, have higher costs associated with them. The tuition tiers allow you to know ahead of time what your bill will be—making financial planning easier.

BASE TUITION AND FEES

- **In-District Residents:** \$105 per credit hour
- **Out-of-District Residents:** \$146 per credit hour

At Three Rivers, we only have two types of fees: resource fees and common fees.

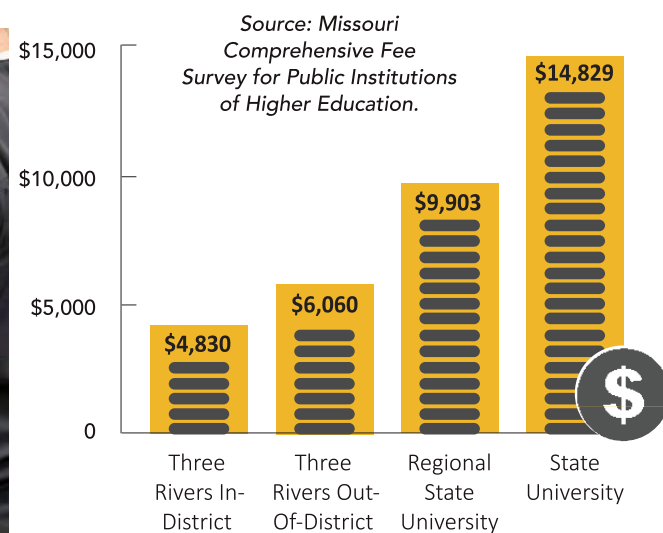
Common Fee: \$56 per credit hour
Helps cover the College's general operation costs.

Resource Fee: \$25 per credit hour
Covers all required digital and physical course materials (textbooks, uniforms, lab kits, course supplies, etc.), ensuring **you have access to all required materials on the first day of classes.**

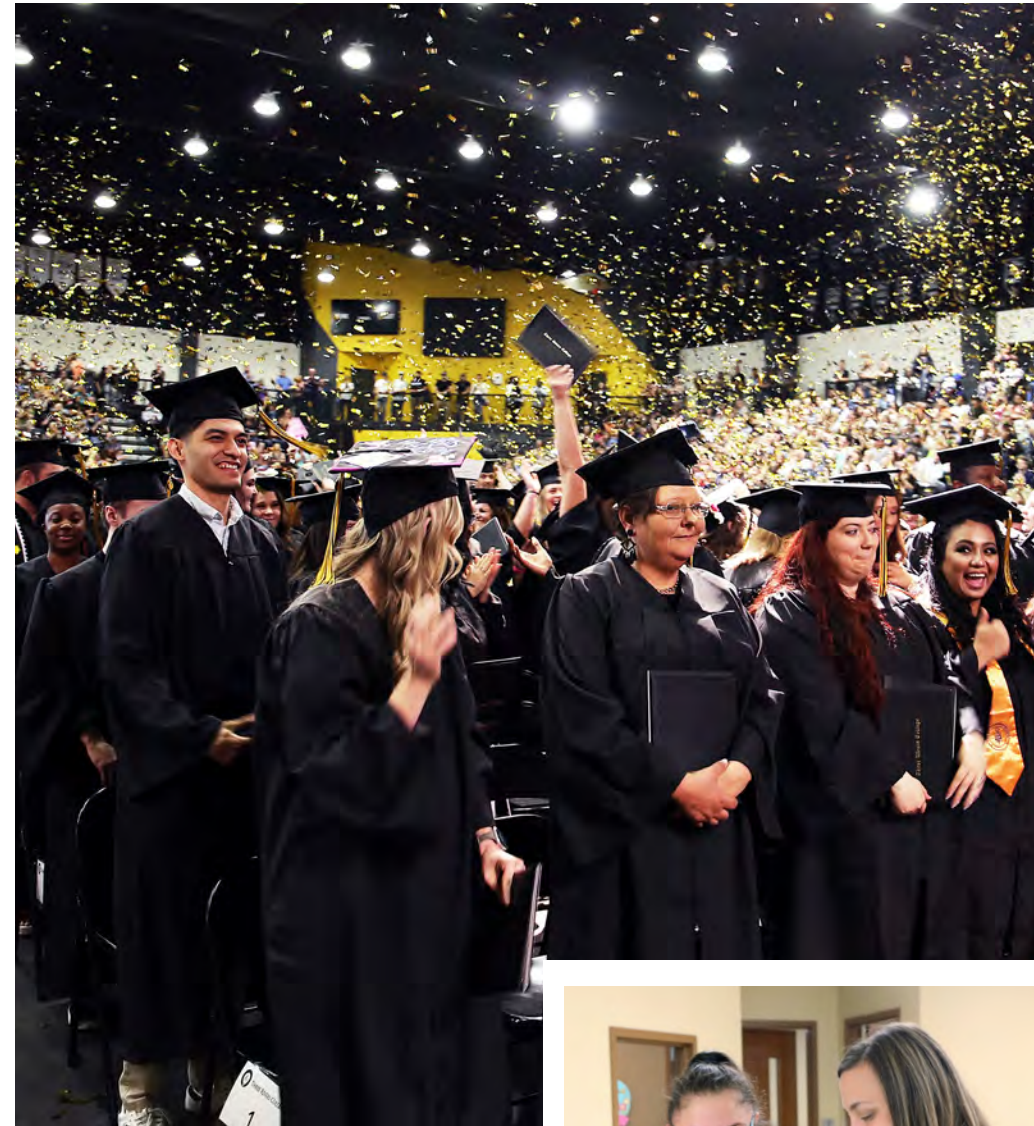


COST COMPARISON

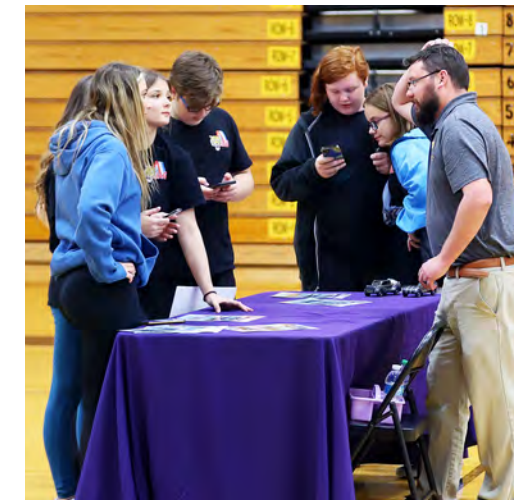

SKILLS FOR A GREAT CAREER

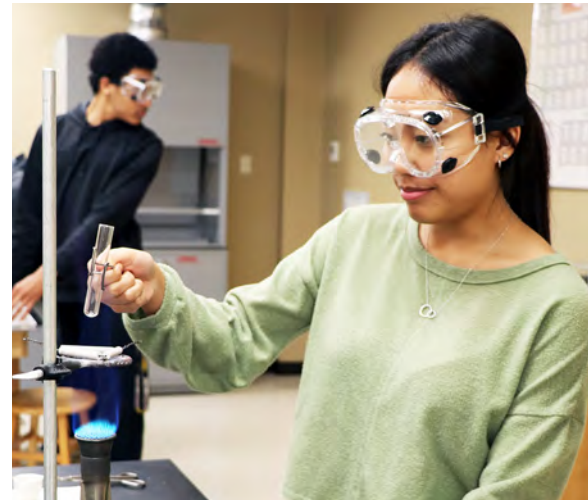
All kinds of high-paying, hands-on careers start at Three Rivers—from agriculture to construction to healthcare to IT, and more.

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FREE TRAINING IN ONE OF FOUR AREAS:

- **Commercial Driving**—Prepare to pass the CDL exam with this five-week program.
- **Construction**—Learn fundamental design and building skills with this eight-week course in Dexter.
- **Welding**—Learn in-demand skills with this eight-week program in Dexter.
- **CNA with Phlebotomy**—Study to become a Certified Nursing Assistant and certified Phlebotomist with this eight-week program.

About Project Drive

Three Rivers College was awarded a federal grant to help prepare Missourians to succeed in the workforce. The Project DRIVE (Direct Rural Initiative Vying for Employment) grant focuses on helping high school seniors get in-demand job training in the summer after their high school graduation. This program runs from October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2025.

VERIFY YOUR IDENTITY

You must verify your identity before you can register for classes. Drop by any of our locations to verify your identity in person, or you can use the link in your Welcome email to verify your identity virtually.

COMPLETE A FAFSA (FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID)

Find the link to FAFSA and instructions at trcc.edu/pay-for-college/fafsa. The FAFSA is for federal and state aid. Priority deadline for state aid is February 1. Three Rivers' school code is 004713.

SUBMIT HIGH SCHOOL/EQUIVALENCY TRANSCRIPT

Request that your high school transcript be sent to Three Rivers after you graduate, or submit your GED/HISET transcript.

SUBMIT PREVIOUS COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS

Request that your transcript(s) from other colleges, including dual credit, be sent to Three Rivers.

SUBMIT PLACEMENT SCORES

Scores from ACT, SAT, or the Accuplacer test, or high school/ equivalency transcripts from within the last five years, are used to place you in the courses right for you. Placement scores must be less than 5 years old. To learn how to take the Accuplacer test, go to trcc.edu/academics/testing-services.

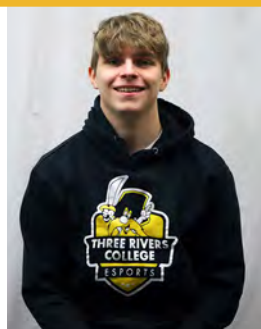
