

## Three Rivers College Minimum Computer System Requirements

**Students are required to have regular, reliable access to a computer with a stable broadband Internet connection.**

The following minimum hardware and software requirements are necessary to access an online class through Three Rivers' current version of Blackboard. Individual instructors may have additional requirements for specific classes. Be sure to check your course syllabi and discuss technology needs with your instructor as early in the class as possible.

If you plan to buy a new computer or plan to use an existing computer for your classes, we recommend that it meet or exceed the following minimum criteria:

Chromebooks and iPads	While some students have had success using Chrome OS on Chromebooks or an iPad, many features are not supported on Blackboard. For example, the Pearson third-party platform and the Honorlock proctoring system are not supported on iPads. Therefore, neither of these devices are recommended.	
Blackboard App	While some students have had success using the Blackboard app, we recommend only using it to view assignments or announcements. We do not recommend submitting assignments as they may not be able to be viewed by your instructor.
